## **Terms and Conditions:**

- "Memorial tree" means a tree that is planted and maintained by the Town of Sexsmith as part of the Community Memorial Tree Program.
- Tree memorial plaques will be returned to the applicant at the end of the useful life of the tree. If the Town of Sexsmith is unsuccessful in contacting an applicant within 180 days, the applicant will be deemed to have forfeited any remaining items.
  - Memorial trees will be planted in Arbour Park through this program. Public Works staff will finalize the exact location before the tree is planted.
- Applications will be accepted year round. Tree planting will take place Spring to Fall of the year requested, as weather permits.
- All trees and plaques will be purchased through the Town of Sexsmith
- Tree Plaques:
  - Are 3 ½ x 3 ½ inches in size. Dates indicating years of birth, death or special occasions are permitted.
  - The Town of Sexsmith retains the right to approve all content for memorial plagues
  - The Town of Sexsmith reserves the right to refuse any application in memory of a publicly controversial individual; a controversial historical leader; a loved one that is not deceased; an animal or a pet.
  - The applicant will provide the content for the plaque. The Town of Sexsmith assumes no responsibility for claims or damages resulting in errors in layout, formatting design, including but not limited to errors in wording, spelling, or other inaccuracies related to inscribed information.
  - The timeline from application to planting may be up to 8 weeks depending on supply and production times for the plaque.
  - o A maximum of one plaque per memorial tree is permitted.
  - Planting of trees and plaques will be undertaken by Town of Sexsmith Public Works staff and these items will become the property and responsibility of the Town of Sexsmith.
  - Only Town of Sexsmith staff are permitted to install or remove plaques on tribute trees.
- The Town of Sexsmith will endeavor to maintain all memorial trees at their original locations.
- In the event that the tree dies due to unknown conditions the Town will replace the tree, the Town has trees in Arbour Park that may be used as memorial trees if one likes to use an established tree.
- The Town of Sexsmith is not responsible for the theft, damage or vandalism to any memorial tree or plaques.
- The Town of Sexsmith reserves the right to decline any application at their discretion.

- A tax receipt will be issued for the total amount gifted. Payment must be made in advance.
