Councillor Barnfield moved that Council accept the minutes of the Regular Council meeting of May 19, 2009.

DELEGATION:

Mr. Jantz gave details as to why he is against trailers. In 1980, he purchased land and was told that the adjacent trailers were to b taken out through agreement. When he went to sell the house, he had to sell it at 11% below market value. It took a year to sell. In total, with utilities and tax, it was about 20% lower than market value.

Painted sky offers the newest and most prestigious subdivision.

Mr. Jantz holds the Town, the developer, and the trailer owner responsible for the loss on his property. He doesn't want another situation like this in Sexsmith. He is sure realtors

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are not telling homeowners that property will be devalued. He is in favor of our Town moving out of this situation.

Councillor Skjaveland said that he has seen really nice trailers in Saskatoon. The trailers didn't affect the subdivision and it was very attractively fenced. The subdivision was not noticeable.

Mr. Jantz said that even putting a basement under a trailer costs more than a regular house basement.

Councillor Barnfield said that there is one subdivision in Grande Prairie that has trailers on basements. Council is not sure what the developers are proposing.

Councillor Sparks in favour of modulars and read-to-move homes. They look much better with sidewalks and curb and gutter. People and Council do not want any house prices to go down but the Town needs affordable housing.

Mr. Jantz said that the quality of double wide trailers is different from trailers. He is against 14 - 16 foot trailers.

Councillor Skjaveland double wide trailers could be on a crawl space or regular basement.
