PUBLIC SESSION	Merry Moore made comments regarding the business located at 9915-95 Street. Merry has no problem with P.O.S. being in town but she does not agree with the barb wire being put up on the chain link fence. She said the barb wire does not send the message that this is a safe community. She does not feel the barbed wire is necessary for vandal restraint since they leave their gates open. She feels there is insufficient parking. Children walking to school are being forced to walk on the road. Councillor Sakundiak agreed that vehicles are parking on the sidewalk. Merry mentioned there is building construction material near the south door of the building that is still above ground. She pointed out this is posing a possible danger to children and fire department if there were a fire. Mayor Lagace said we could bring these issues up to P.O.S. Councillor Sakundiak commented he no longer notices the barbed wire. Councillor Barnfield mentioned there are other businesses in Town that have barbed wire along the tops of their fences. Councillor Barnfield further noted that it is better to have a building filled and in use rather than left deteriorating. Merry said there are three toilets left outside, snow is coming off the garage roof a danger to those walking by and she believes	

show is coming off the garage roof a danger to those walking by and she believes there is a drain in the garage that is going into the Town storm drain. She also feels there was a lack of openness from the Town when the land use was changed from institutional to commercial. Merry pointed out there is water pooling outside the library. Mayor Lagace said the fix for this problem is being looked at in the budget. We are waiting for a cost on the work. Merry said the Town should
