DELEGATIONS

Melissa Atkins - Citizen

Melissa read notes she had prepared regarding the bylaws on restricted breeds in the Town of Sexsmith and her views on it. She has suggested that Council put the "Canine Good Neighbors Test" in the dog bylaw to relax the restricted breed requirements. Councillor Siggelkow inquired if Melissa thought all dogs should be removed from the restricted dog list if they passed the Canine Good Neighbors Test. Melissa said yes they should be.

Councillor Barnfield commented he had been attacked by a Staffordshire Terrier in the past. Melissa replied this is why there should be a case by case study. There is a stigma around these breeds but this does not mean that they will bite. I have never had an issue with my dog. Councillor Barnfield commented that this breed of dog is more apt to bite. Melissa explained this is due to bad owners.

Councillor Siggelkow pointed out that due to the strength of the bite of this breed of dog the Town has imposed this bylaw.

Melissa explained the SPCA offers a course on how to act around animals. The course informs children on how to act and behave around dogs. Mayor Lagace asked if Melissa is wanting Council to be responsible for educating all children. Councillor Cooke asked administration how many of these types of dogs were

currently in our town. This would have to be looked at. A running total is not currently being monitored. Councillor Cooke also mentioned children in Sexsmith are being taught in the classroom about appropriate behavior around dogs. She questioned if it would be feasible to have the Canine Good Neighbors Testing done at the dog owner's expense. CAO, Carolyn Gaunt read out the extent of a Canine Good Neighbors Test.

Councillor Skjaveland mentioned that he believed if a dog was looked after right from a pup they will turn out to be good dogs. Melissa responded that she has raised her dogs from pups. They were fixed at a young age to reduce possibility of aggression. She does not want to muzzle her dogs. She feels this stigmatizes them. She does not want to be labeled. She also wondered how they could comply with the bylaw on a rental property.

Councillor Siggelkow questioned if the County does the Canine Good Neighbors Testing. This will be investigated. Councillor Sakundiak pointed out you only hear about restricted dogs that bite. Any dog will snap if you get in their face. Councillor Cooke suggested taking out the muzzling requirement but leaving in the leash requirement. She asked Melissa if she would help in starting a dog park. Melissa said yes she would. Mayor Lagace commented dog parks need to be controlled by owners. We would need responsible dog owners to take care of the park. Melissa said she would like to volunteer to do something like this.
