## **DELEGATION** Jason Nesbitt, Interim Co-Fire Chief

Nellie Sterr

Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt read a letter he prepared. This weekend no senior firefighters were in Town. Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt feels there is enough work to keep a person busy full time to continue in Co-Fire Chief position and will stepping down from the position and Matt Klassen will be Interim Firechief. Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt does not have the time. There were questions about the amount of training done but Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt says older firefighters are not as eager to dedicate time to training as some of the younger firefighters are.

Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt wants to find the right person for the job. He forwarded \$5,000 towards the rescue truck. It is fully operational.

Average response time is 7 minutes, 45 seconds. For medical response, the best time is just over 3 minutes.

The firefighters participated in community service on the first day of school, patrolling for people to slow down. During Fire Prevention Week, October 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, the firemen will go to the schools in Town.

There is a DG course in November. Co-Fire Chiefs Matt Klassen and Nesbitt, as well as Fireman Brian Ball will be taking a safety codes course. Two firemen are taking 1001 courses, which will have 10 career qualified Level II firemen and 7 firemen at Level I.

Co-Fire Chief Nesbitt got the Tahoe painted, free of charge. It will be ready within 2 weeks. There are 12 to 13 EMRs. There are four vehicles but only three bays. Officer on call could take one vehicle home, reducing the response time of the officer on call. New radios have reduced response time.

The August 26<sup>th</sup> fire caused a loss of \$30,000 - \$40,00 on the fire truck and an equipment loss of \$44,000.
