Councillor Barnfield asked if they have costs on the equipment. Waldie said they are mostly just working with the engineers at this point but the costs of each machine is approximately \$10,000.

CAO, Carolyn Gaunt asked how your enrollment compares to other years. Waldie said they had 105 students last year so this year is about average.

Councillor Siggelkow asked when their completion date is. Is it next summer? Waldie said that it would not be completed by next summer.

Councillor Sakundiak asked if the public will be able to access the old gym as well. Waldie said at this time they are just focusing on the fitness center having public access.

Mayor Lagace commented that the sidewalk in front of PRBI should be completed soon.
