## **DELEGATION** Dave Campbell, County Enforcement

All calls from 8:30 a.m. -4:30 p.m. go to front office, then to an officer. This provides for quicker response. After hours, the calls automatically go to officer. Sometimes calls are lost with faulty radio waves. The Town should phone and not email. In Sexsmith, County Enforcement mostly deals with unsightly premises and highway traffic control.

A person can only do a U-turn at intersections by doing a turn, stop, and then continue on and only when safe to do so.

If tickets are written under Highway Traffic Act, then there are no additional fees for legal representation.

There are a lot of animal complaints but no laws for cats. What are Council's thoughts on cats? Cat bylaws are very hard to enforce.

County Enforcement would like the town to take a look at our fines for animal control.

Insurance fees do not go against drivers' licenses. Outstanding warrants are only activated if a person with an outstanding warrant is stopped.

Eleven officers, including animal control, work for County Enforcement.

Councillor Siggelkow asked, "Do they enforce alcohol infractions?" Yes. Kids are drinking at the skateboard park. Enforcement does a walkthrough the skateboard park and investigates suspicions.

On unsightly premises, they deliver orders as directed by the Town.

Questions were answered on 24-hour suspensions.

There were questions about large truck in personal driveway. The truck can get there but can't be on the road.

On unsightly premises, a hefty fine can be given for failing to comply with "Order". There is no appeal to the "Order", the only option is to clean up. Beaverlodge has a bylaw in place.

Council was asked it they could change a bylaw – only allowing trucks in for deliveries and not allow them for any service. Call Dave about paving equipment.
