#### **DELEGATION**

#### Pat Zelenak, from Play Works, Presentation on Water Play

Ms. Zelenak said the Town needs to consider the site and drainage system. Playworks does components, park design and layout drawings. Playworks can do complete installation or partial installation. It is \$140,000 to \$150,000. CFEP grants would be 50/50. Water can be recycled at the beginning or even later. Washroom facilities are not usually installed. Treated water system requires qualified personnel. Glycol is added for winterizing. The size is 75 feet x 90 feet. Whitecourt has a recirculating water play park, at a cost of \$225,000. Without the recirculation it would be \$175,000. It could be user pay. It could be staged in but Water Works would have to know from the beginning.

Mayor Lagace thanked Ms. Zelenak for the presentation and said that the Town will look at a water play park in future budgets.

#### **DELEGATION**

#### Everett Cooke, Sexsmith Fire Department

Mr. Cooke questioned if the current rescue truck could be sold, as it was donated by Talisman. Mr. Cooke presented reasoning on back up vehicles.

- They would not sell for high value dollar.
- They could be used as backup vehicles for Town emergencies.
- The old fire truck could be used as a training vehicle.

Councillor Siggelkow wants the percentage of costs per department, on overall costs in a pie chart format.

Mr. Cooke went over the 2008 statistics. There were a record 143 calls for service. The Fireman's Ball is on March 14, 2009. The Sexsmith Fire Department has sent the Letter of Intent for the new rescue truck. The new rescue truck should be here by March 14th, 2009.
