Rebecca stated that the same advertising that needs to be done on off weeks in the Tribune would be half the cost of a weekly Sexsmith Sentinel. She stated that if half of the readership is in Sexsmith, half of the content would be Sexsmith related. There are no regular advertisers in Sexsmith to support the paper as it is currently. She stated that being a weekly newspaper brings in revenue from national advertisers as well.

Tanya Brown from the Physiotherapy clinic presented with Todd McClenaghan and Greg Turgeon from South 40 Dental who are interested in renting some space at the physiotherapy clinic to open a dental clinic. Parking is an issue right now. They also wanted to discuss signage. There are 7 stalls behind the building but the medical clinic uses half of those. There is space to the east of the physiotherapy clinic which could accommodate parking. The dentist office would be prepared to open right away if the parking situation was resolved. They are a very busy practice and they have a large number of patients from Sexsmith. Job creation would be another benefit to have a dentist office in

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Sexsmith. They are looking at about 7 chairs. They are thinking about starting out with 4 days per week.
