Those items haven't been tendered. For the upcoming year he would like to use the contingency on projects that are approved rather than putting it towards untendered projects.

Should have the street improvements decided now so that surveying can be done. Would like to do the key sites that the Town wants but would like to get the design done and tender at the beginning of the year. The contingency shouldn't be used on extras.
