Mr. McGrath was present for further discussion on the Public Works Shop and what is to be done or recommended.

# BUSINESS ARISING

Mr. McGrath stated that the tender package was for estimates to make the shop an "operational" shop and the costs estimates that he presented last time were to fix it to be a cold storage shop. If the shop is repaired, it must be done to the current building code. The building is 40 years old and is nearing its life cycle. To make it operational requires a steel beam down the centre.

For demolition of the Public Works shop, the concrete would have to be hauled away. Estimated cost for the demo is \$20,000. To build a new shop, the costs are about \$100 per sq. ft. for steel building (stronger, non-combustible) and about \$125 per sq. ft. for office space. Wood construction is about \$85 per sq. ft.

Mayor Lagace declared a break at 7:25 p.m. Councillor Jickling left the meeting and returned at 7:37 p.m.
